National Curriculum

As Writers We will develop our writing by learning a journey tale: the story of Nail Soup and writing our own versions. We will perform a rhyming poem and write shape poems. After half term, we will write our own warning tales inspired by 'The Tunnel' by Anthony Browne. We will develop our non-fiction writing skills by writing instructions and a recount. We will focus on learning and practising spelling patterns and we will continue to focus on letter formation and handwriting size.

As Readers we will use the Accelerated Reader scheme for our daily reading. We will read Cliffhanger by Jacqueline Wilson and The Ice Palace by Robert Swindells and use the ERIC approach to help us understand these books. We will continue to use Cracking Comprehension to develop our comprehension skills.

As Mathematicians we will follow the Nation Curriculum and study place value, addition and subtraction, multiplication and division. We will be learning our 3, 4 and 8 times tables.

As Scientists we will identify that animals, including humans, need the right types and amount of nutrition. We will learn about skeletons and muscles. Later, we will be studying rocks .

As Geographers we will study the United Kingdom (UK) and its main physical and human features. We will look at changes in coasts over time and learn about the water cycle and rivers.

As Historians we will be finding out about the Industrial Revolution, focussing on railways.

In Art we will be looking at animals and , as well as sketching and painting, we will make collages inspired by the artist Megan Coyle.

In Design & Technology we will link our Design and Technology unit to our English and write instructions as we learn how to make soup using seasonal ingredients.

As Musicians we will learn Harvest songs to perform at our Harvest assembly. We will also explore rhythmic patterns.

In P.E we will develop invasion games and follow our REAL PE and Gym programmes.

In Computing we will follow the Purple Mash Programme and learn about E-Safety, spreadsheets and branching databases.

In R.E we will explore the questions: What do Christians believe about God? Has Christmas lost its true meaning?

In PHSE we will use the Jigsaw programme and explore being in my world and celebrating difference.

In Spanish we will learn about the country and cultural aspects of this subject and basic greetings.
