### Christmas Cards

The STEM Hub have created a **STEM Surprise Festive Count down** where every day a new challenge will be released to the children.

Follow the link and it will take you to the advent calendar where a new 'window' will be opened each day. In each window there will be a video explaining the challenge for children to complete.

The first challenge is for children to invent a device for 2 or 3 people to use in a small boat to collect plastic from the ocean in order to help save the North Pole in the Arctic. Children can draw pictures of their device and label it. They can then take a photo of their drawing and send it in for us to see!
