You will need your number line and a pencil and paper for this lesson.</p>
<b>Fri 22nd</b>	<p><b>Make sure you:</b></p> <ol style="list-style-type: none"> <li>1. Include facts and pictures.</li> <li>2. Split your facts into sections like we did for our penguin fact file.</li> <li>3. Use capital letters, full stop and finger spaces when writing you sentences.</li> </ol>	<p><b>Worksheet on dojo</b></p> <p>Addition by counting on.
