

Rules for 'Live' sessions on MICROSOFT TEAMS

- This is remote schooling the expectations are the same as it would be if you were in school.
- Attend every TEAMS lesson. Parents must notify the teacher if you can't.
- Be on time every 'live' lesson has a clear start time. If you are late you will miss vital information.
- You should not be leaving the lesson you wouldn't do this on a normal school day.
- Be dressed appropriately you don't want to embarrass yourself or others.
- There should be an adult in the room monitoring you in case you need <u>technical</u> help but they are not there to prompt or give you answers (we need to know what you can/cannot do).
- Let others in the room know you are in a 'live' session and that other children can potentially see and hear them.
- Turn off your microphone in the lesson unless asked to speak by the teacher.
- The use of the camera is at the teacher's discretion.
- Only use the chat box for comments to the teacher.
- Interact respectfully with others as you would do in the classroom.
- Be aware that lessons are monitored and that chat is recorded.
- Evidence of your work needs to be posted to the teacher via ClassDojo or TEAMS.
