Lesson 5 Support Sheet

Introduce days of the week

This lesson will teach you the seven days of the week in Spanish.

Key Language

Los días	=	the days of the week
lunes	=	Monday
martes	=	Tuesday
miércoles	=	Wednesday
jueves	=	Thursday
viernes	=	Friday
sábado	=	Saturday
domingo	=	Sunday

<u>**Please note</u>**: In Spanish, days of the week (like months of the year) do <u>not</u> start with a capital letter. The only time they will start with a capital letter is when they are at the start of a sentence.</u>

<u>Slide 1</u>	Lesson objective	How to say 'days of the week' in Spanish. Play the audio file a few times and repeat.
<u>Slides 2-8</u>	Days of the week	Play the audio file on each slide a few times and repeat. Listen carefully and read what is on the slide.
<u>Slide 9</u>	Spanish & English	Each day of the week in Spanish is now shown with it's equivalent in English. Play each voice file again a couple of times to ensure you are familiar with these words and how they are pronounced in Spanish. You will need to know them for the next slide.
<u>Slide 10</u>	Matching exercise	On a piece of paper, using the spellings on this slide, can you match the Spanish to the English? The answers will appear one by one as you click.
<u>Slides 11-17</u>	Hidden words	Each day of the week is hidden behind a star. Can you guess which day of the week it is? Beware that they are no longer in order! The answers appear on the click. Say out loud in Spanish which day of the week you believe it is before playing the voice file to double check your pronunciation. The order is:
		 martes viernes miércoles sábado lunes jueves domingo

<u>Slide 18</u>	Spellings	Have you been reading and listening carefully? On a piece of paper attempt to remember the spellings from memory using the gap-fill to support and guide you. Play the audio files too as these may help you. The answers will appear on the next slide.
<u>Slide 19</u>	Answers	Check your answers with what you see on the slide. Did you manage to fill in all the missing letters correctly?
<u>Slide 20</u>	The days of the week	A final check of the days of the week in Spanish? Can you remember them from memory yet? Why not play each audio file one last time and then see if you can do it without the slide to support you.

Once you have finished this lesson you may like to complete the fun worksheets in the activities section. These will help you remember the days of the week and you can always revisit the lesson when needed. Now, every day you can say what day of the week it is in SPANISH!
