



Climate and Geographical

Features: Iceland is sometimes known as the 'Land of Fire and Ice'. This is because it is covered by glaciers but also has more than 20 active volcanoes.

In Iceland, the climate is cold, windy and cloudy for most of the year.

Because of the country's high latitude, in the summer months the sun sets for only a few hours per day. This is known as the "midnight sun". In contrast, there are only around 4-5 hours of daylight during mid-winter.

Wildlife: Sheep are the most common farm animals in Iceland. You will also see many seabirds like puffins and whale watching is popular too.
