Remember to use a comma when you start your sentence with a preposition (or a prepositional phrase like, Above the beach, and finish your sentence with a full stop. For example: Below, the rolling waves crashed over the rocky beach. In the distance, they could hear the low rumble of the other trolls, feasting on their hoard of freshly caught fish.
