Clee View Morning Drop Off

To help parents who must take children to both sites, we now have a Teaching Assistant outside at Clee View from 8.30am. This adult will be on the path toward school supervising the children as they line up.

We encourage all children with scooters to put them in the shed first and then line up. The member of staff will then stay with the children until they go into class by 8.40am. If you are taking children to both sites, you can drop your child at Clee View just after 8.30am and this should give you more time to get to Sandpits Road by 8.50am.

Polite reminder about parking

Please refrain from parking on the zig-zags lines outside each site. These are here for everyone's safety – children and adults.

We have also been informed about ongoing issues of parking by Whitefriars housing which is warden controlled. We respectfully ask parents/carers not to park on private property; to always be mindful of designated resident parking areas and to ensure access is always available to ambulances. We are aware the matter has been passed to the police.

As always, we kindly ask you to respect all our neighbours when dropping off/collecting children at both sites. Please ensure pavements/driveways are not blocked and residents can access their properties easily and safely.

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Class Dojo – information for parents/carers



We have over 450 parents and carers signed up and using Dojo, and it is a vital communication tool for us all.

Because we are using Class Dojo so widely, we thought it might be a good idea to re-issue the guidelines for use.

Unacceptable use:

Recently we have found that the system has unfortunately been used inappropriately. If you are in a position where you are unhappy with something involving your child in the class or within school, then Class Dojo is not the way to report this. Instead, we ask that you telephone, email or make an appointment to discuss the matter in person with either the class teacher or a Senior Leader.

Reporting absences and urgent messages:

We cannot guarantee that teachers will have the opportunity to check Dojo at certain times so please do not use the Dojo to report child absences from school. The procedure should always be to telephone the school office and leave a message.

Similarly, if your child has different collection arrangements after school, please telephone the office.

Behaviour system:

Recognition of good behaviour in a variety of different forms are given by all members of our school staff one of them being Dojo points and you should be receiving a notification when your child receives the positive behaviour points.

We will also notify parents by Dojo if a child has had difficulties in following the school's behaviour system and has required some additional support. However, if you have any concerns or wish to discuss this further, we ask that you telephone the school and ask to speak to the class teacher rather than send a message back via Dojo.

Availability of staff

Teachers will endeavour to respond to a Dojo message within 24 hours of receiving it, but all staff have their Class Dojo apps set to "Quiet hours" which means they will not receive messages after 5.00pm or before 8.00am and not at all at weekends.

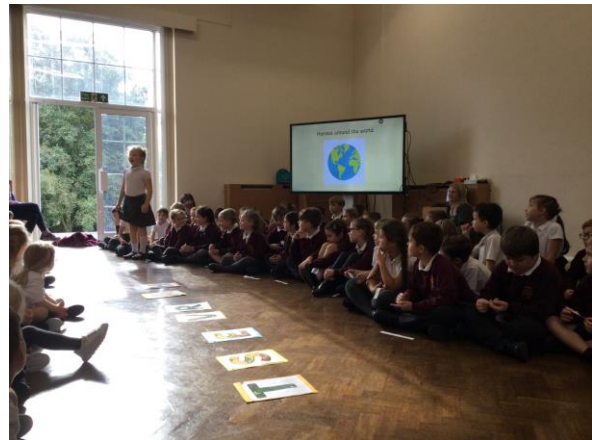
