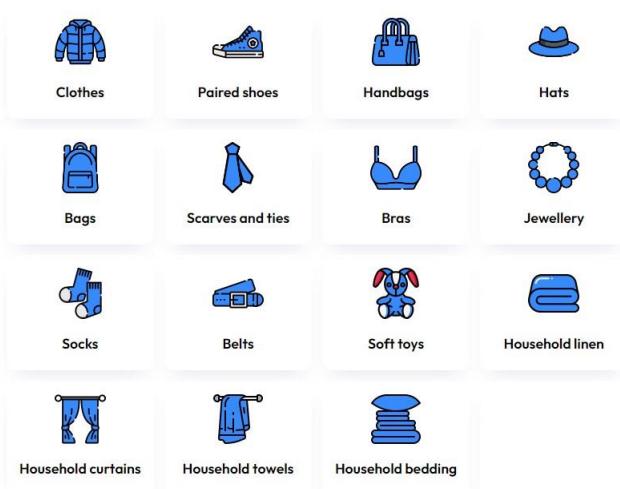

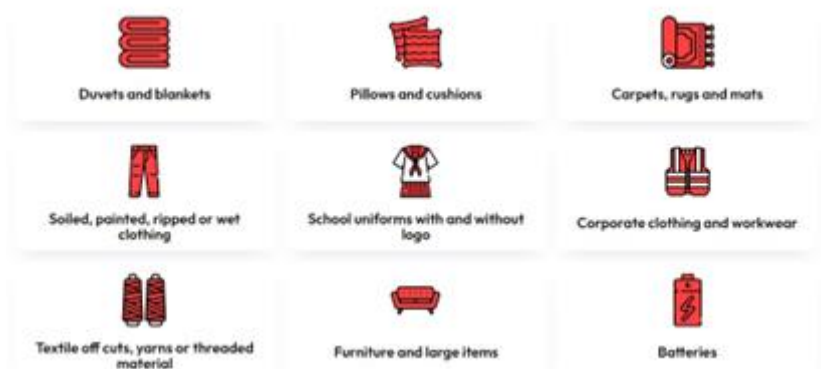
Bag2School - Tuesday 27th February

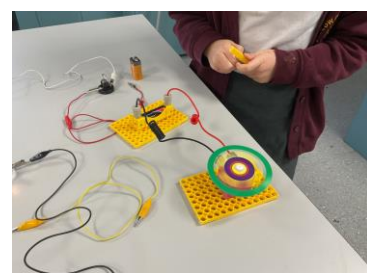
