## PARKING

We continue to receive complaints from the residents of Whitefriars. Please be aware the car park there is private which the residents pay for. We have been informed the local police, council and MP have been contacted and residents have been told to take pictures of illegally parked cars and of those that are blocking driveways or parked dangerously.

Not only should we respect our neighbours and their property, but it is essential that ambulances can attend in emergencies. Residents must also be able to access their own parking area and vehicles to attend important appointments.

Whilst we appreciate parking is very limited, we respectfully ask you to find alternative, safe parking places when dropping off/collection your children.

### <u>Appointments</u>

There is an increasing number of pupils leaving during the school day for appointments. Please try and book appointments during holidays or after school. If this is not possible, please try and book them as near to home time as possible so the children are missing as little valuable learning time as possible (core subjects such as maths and English are taught in the morning sessions).




### **Year 3 Orienteering Experience**
