School ends at 3.15pm (Reception 3pm)

Total time: this amounts to 32.5 hours in a typical week.

Please note:

There will be staff supervision on the gate at our Clee View site from 8:30am daily. Gates on both sites will open at 8:40am and locked at 8:50am. Children arriving after this time will need to enter through the main reception of both sites.

Children who attend Breakfast Club need to arrive for 8:10am at Clee View and 8.15 at Sandpits Road. They will be admitted through the main reception door at Clee View and into Tree tops at Sandpits Road.
