### First News comes to Ludlow Primary School



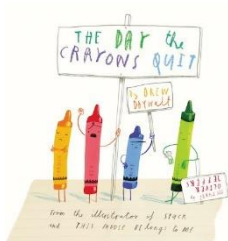

### Key Stage 1

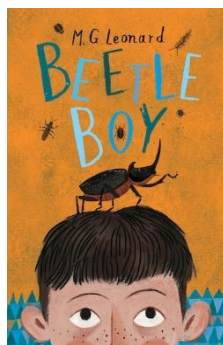
#### ***The Day the Crayons Quit by Drew Daywalt***
