National Curriculum

<u>As Writers</u>, we will read and appraise poetry with figurative language, and write our own winter poems using similes and metaphors. Use Talk for Writing (Manchester Ridge-back) to write chronological reports. We will also use Talk for Writing to write a portal story: Eye of the Storm.

<u>As Readers</u> we will read Harry Potter and the Chamber of Secrets by JK Rowling. <u>As Mathematicians</u>, we will develop our understanding of fractions. We will learn efficient methods for calculation using the four operations $(+, -, x, \div)$. We will develop our problem solving and reasoning skills, focussing on multiplication and division.

<u>As Scientists</u>. We will be studying properties of materials, including solubility and investigating reversible changes.

<u>As Historians</u> we will be looking at key beliefs throughout history from the Stone Age to the 17th Century. We will also learn about beliefs in Ancient civilisations.

<u>As Geographers</u> we will describe and understand human and physical geography by studying South America.

As designers we will learn to design and make a motorised car, create circuits using electronics kits that employ a number of components and cut materials with precision and refine the finish with appropriate tools

As artists we will be looking at the artwork of different cultures and creating our own batik.

<u>As Musicians</u>, we will be using Sparkyard to develop an understanding of interrelated dimensions and musical vocabulary and improvise musical patterns while exploring jazz.

<u>In P.E.</u>, use the Real PE program to focus our physical development in Real Dance and Real gym.

In Computing, we will develop our understanding databases and game creator. In R.E. we will answer the following questions: How significant is it for Christians to believe that God intended Jesus to die? How are sacred teachings and stories interpreted by Jews today?

<u>In PHSE</u> we will use the Jigsaw programme. Our topics are dreams and goals and healthy me.

<u>In Spanish</u> we will learn to speak about the weather and answer the question what is the date.
