Read and discuss the text Machine Gunners and discuss emotions and feelings during conflict. We will also discuss and analyse a variety of non-fiction texts to identify features and meaning.

As Mathematicians, we will:

Develop our understanding of the link between fractions, decimals and percentages. We will use the White Rose Planning to build on our problem solving and reasoning skills.

As Scientists, we will:

Focus on the study of electricity. We will focus on how to create a circuit to make a bulb brighter or buzzer louder. We will then start to study Evolution and Charles Darwin.

As Historians we will:

Learn about Innovation and Industry through the ages including development in weaponry and warfare. We will use evidence to interpret the past and make new meaning.
