

As Writers, we will be writing a finding tale using character and setting description with ideas taken from The Owl who is afraid of the dark. Our poetry is based on rhyming pairs. We will be writing a recount of our trip to Ludlow Castle and writing about an aboriginal tale, Tiddik The Frog.

As Readers we will continue to develop our phonic knowledge in daily sessions. We will focus on reading with fluency and expression and answering questions on what we have read. We will read Fantasticc Mr Fox in ERIC.

As Mathematicians, we will study fractions and time. We will also collect statistical data linked to our science investigations and study position and direction.

<u>As Scientists</u> We will study plants, Evolution and inheritance, Electricity and recap other areas of science studied so far.

<u>As Historians</u> we will look at castles—their features and the jobs of those who lived and worked in them. We will also make links with the Mortimer Project and visit Ludlow Castle.

<u>As Geography</u> we will study Australia and understand the human and physical features of the country.

<u>As Artisits</u>, we will look at the work of Hokusai and seascapes from other historical eras. Using this knowledge, we shall use collage to create a seascape of out own.

As Musicians, we will be focussing on our learning of the recorder and singing as a choir.

<u>In P.E.</u> we will: develop our gym and our multi-skills following our Real PE and Real gym PE programmes. We will also go swimming at Ludlow Leisure Centre.
