National Curriculum

As Writers, we will be writing a non-chronological report about castles. We will develop our use of a range of punctuation, sentence types, conjunctions and subheadings. We will use this information to create a booklet complete some topical description. We are also writing about Jack and The Beanstalk to learn a traditional tale.

As Readers we will continue to develop our phonic knowledge in daily sessions. We will focus on reading with fluency and expression and answering questions on what we have read. We will read The Owl Who is Afraid of the Dark as a whole class novel and continue to use our ERIC approach to help us understand the book.

As Mathematicians, we will study fractions and time. We will also collect statistical data linked to our science investigations and study position and direction.

As Scientists we will study animals including humans, looking at animal groups, and offspring. We will study lifecycles of animals and the basic needs of animals including food and hygiene.

As Historians we will look at castles—their features and the jobs of those who lived and worked in them. We will also make links with the Mortimer Project and visit Ludlow Castle.

As Artists, we will look at the work of Hokusai and seascapes from other historical eras. Using this knowledge, we shall use collage to create a seascape of our own.

As Musicians, we will be focussing on our learning of the recorder and singing as a choir.

In P.E, we will: develop our gym and our multi-skills following our Real PE and Real gym PE programmes. We will also go swimming at Ludlow Leisure Centre.

In Computing, we will use Purple Mash to develop our knowledge of spreadsheets.

In R.E, we will explore the good news that believers feel Jesus brings.

In PSHE we will use the Jigsaw programme and explore relationships.
