We entered a **Dodgeball** Competition at Ludlow School yesterday and came 4th.

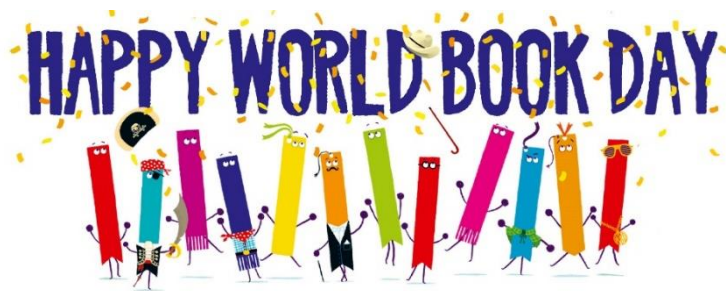
Well done to all those who took part!
