Dear Parents/Carers,

We now have final numbers for the Year Three children returning to school on Monday 6th - Thursday 9th July. There will be a maximum of fifteen children per group. The groups will be taught by Mrs Mellish and Miss Davenport, the Year Four Teachers.

The following will apply:

- They will be at **Sandpits Road** site starting at 9.30am and finishing at 2.30pm.
- We would be grateful if only one parent could bring your child to school.
- The only access to school is through the front gate.
- We ask that on your way in and out of school, that all adults and children follow the current social distancing guidelines.
- Resources – please do not send in resources we will provide all equipment for the children.
- Reading books – No reading books will be given out to reduce risk of contamination; however, children can bring in books from home to read independently.
- Food at lunchtime will be **packed lunches only**. You are free to send a packed lunch in with your child; however, school can provide a packed lunch (at the normal cost) if required but it will need to be booked in the usual way using School Money. Please log on to see the filling choices.
- Drinks bottles – children will need to bring in their own named drinks bottle.
- Hand washing – children will be required to wash their hands upon entry into school. Children will be reminded and encouraged to wash their hands regularly throughout the day as well as using hand cleanser gel.
- **Social distancing – we are sure that you will agree that some children may find social distancing difficult. We will do our best to ensure social distancing but, at the same time, we would like to reassure you that if your child needs reassuring or comforting then staff will do so.**
- Classroom layout. DFE guidelines have been implemented in classrooms. There will be no soft furnishings or soft toys. We have also had to put into storage some of the resources as they are difficult to keep clean and sanitised to a high standard. All children will have their own desk.
- Uniform – **Normal school uniform should be worn**. Children are asked to have a pair of trainers in their bag.
- No PE kits are required so trainers will allow children to still participate in physical activity.

If your child is not attending school, we continue to set home learning.
