- Describe what you think A Bao A Qu looks like. Perhaps it is huge or small, slimy or scaly, scary or cute. Think of as many adjectives as you can to describe your creature.
- How does your A Bao Qu move? Does it scurry or slither, bounce or slide? Is it fast or slow? Perhaps it is invisible when it moves or changes colour to blend into the background.
- What word described how the music was put together? Look at the video at 3:20 to remind yourself if you need to.
- Try moving like an A Bao A Qu whilst the music is playing. Remember when the pitch of the music goes higher so must your A Bao A Qu.
