Reading Comprehension 10:45am – 11:15am 30 Minutes TEAMs Learning	How to Make a Sandwich Read through the text together as a class. Read and discuss the questions in section A and B Children then independently answer the questions. DO NOT DO SECTION C. We will mark these in tomorrow's session.
