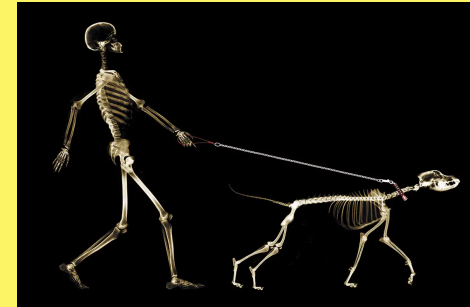
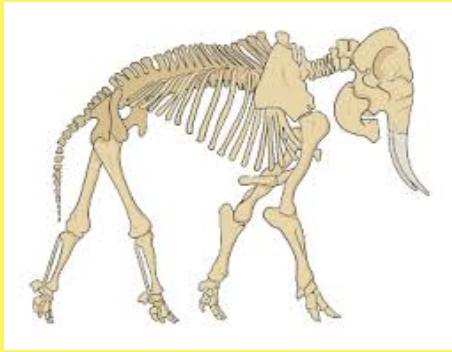

# SKELETONS!



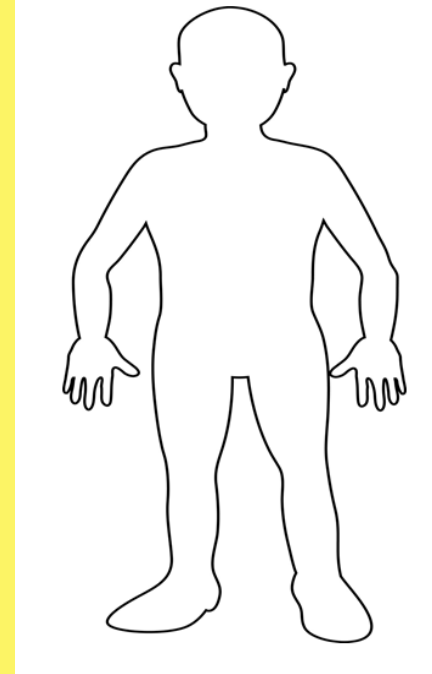
WALT look at skeletons and find out what we know.

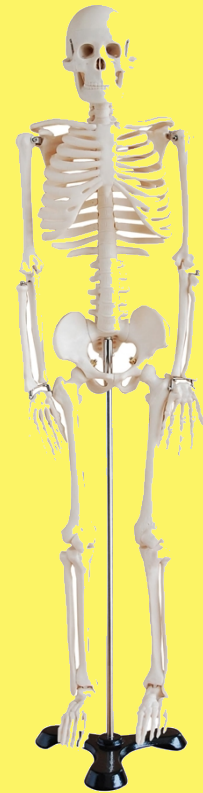
Now let's look at this model of a skeleton.

Can you feel your jaw bone?







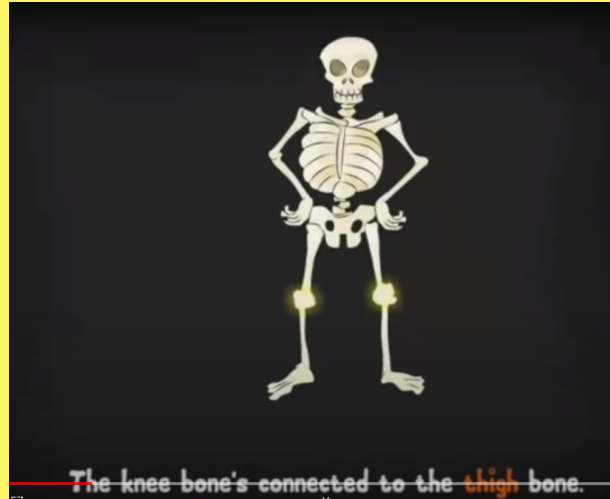
