Reading Comprehension 10:45am – 11:15am Mystery of Strange Beast Continues 30 Minutes TEAMs Learning	How to Make your Own Roman Mosaic Read through the text together as a class. Read and discuss the questions in section A and B Children then independently answer the questions. DO NOT DO SECTION C. We will mark these in tomorrow's session.
English 11:15am – 12:15pm 1 hour TEAMs Learning	WALT write the Method using imperative verbs and adverbs We will recap what an imperative verb is and how we should use it. We will also recap using adverbs and time adverbials. It is important that we use these when we are writing the method part of our instructions. Children can look back at previous lessons to help remind them. Children need to number their instructions and make sure they are in order. Teacher will model writing and then children will write their own using their plan to help them.
