Absence

Covid Testing

The school has had a couple of recent enquiries where children are displaying symptoms of Covid and parents are not sure which test to give them.

If your child displays any of the 3 symptoms (a high temperature; a new, continuous cough, or a loss or change of smell/taste) then the whole household needs to isolate. A PCR test should be booked either online or by phoning 111.

A Rapid Lateral Flow test should not be used.
