National Curriculum

As Writers, we will: become more confident when writing sentences using capital letters, finger spaces and full stops. We will use interesting and exciting vocabulary choices in our writing. We will use our increasing phonics knowledge to help us sound out words, spelling them with increasing accuracy. We will learn how to use prefixes and suffixes when spelling. We will; become confident in forming our capital letters accurately.

As Readers, we will : Continue to develop our phonic knowledge by learning new sounds. We will decode familiar and unfamiliar words using our Fred talk. We will begin to read with more fluency . We will talk about what we have read.

As Mathematicians, we will: We will focus on place value of numbers to 100. We will sort objects, count in 2s, 5s and 10, find one more and one less, compare groups of objects and order numbers. We will focus on making sure we form our numbers correctly and that we are confident at representing numbers to 20 in a variety of ways. We will continue to practise adding and subtracting within 20. We will begin to look at the concept of multiplication and division; focusing on doubling, halving, making groups and sharing equally. We will learn position language as well as looking at values of coins.

As Scientists, we will: Continue to look at animals including humans; learning about animals groups and structures. We will then look at plants. We will label parts of a plant and learn what they need to stay alive.

As Historians we will: learn about significant people from the past and discuss their lives.

As Artists we will: Design products that use sliders mechanisms and structures that can support weight.

As Musicians, we will: explore pitch and beat.

In P.E, we will: develop our multi-skills following our real PE and gym program.

In Computing, we will: use purple mash to learn coding.

In R.E, we will: ask the question 'Who are Jewish people and what do they believe?'
