Acorns Nursery forms part of the exciting Early Years Foundation Stage department at Ludlow Primary School. We are a setting taking children from the age of 2 years. We have our own self-contained, spacious facilities together with a large natural outdoor area. We have full access to all school facilities. We have a nurturing, supportive and experienced team of staff who value each child as unique and independent learners. Our provision is child-led which means that staff continually observe, assess and interact with children to get a comprehensive grasp of their stage of development, unique styles of learning and areas of interest. It is important to us that all parents are actively encouraged to be involved in their child's education and we place great importance on communication between the setting and home.

We understand that choosing the right setting for your child is an extremely important decision.

We are open term time – Monday to Friday – 9.00am to 3.00 pm. We offer morning (9.00am-11.30am), afternoon (12.30pm-3.00pm) or full day sessions.

We offer 24U funded places for 2 year olds and also 15 and 30 hour funded places.

Taster Days - Ludlow CE School - CANCELLED

Pupil Sickness

We appear to have a stomach bug doing the rounds, particularly in year 5. May we please reiterate that children **SHOULD NOT RETURN** to school until a full 48 hours has passed since their last 'episode' of sickness and/or diarrhoea. Even though they may appear to be fully recovered before 48 hours, they may still be contagious to other pupils and staff.

If this time expires mid-way through a day, we would suggest they do not return until the next full school day to err on the side of caution. Many thanks for your co-operation.

Year 6 children have had a presentation from a 'Kooth' representative. Kooth is a free, safe and anonymous online mental wellbeing community where children can find help and advice for anything that might be worrying them. It's also a child-friendly place for them to chat to other youngsters about similar interests and get creative. All messages and comments sent via Kooth are monitored to ensure that it is a safe place for children to communicate. Currently, it is only available for children 11+ but it might be something to think about for your child in the future, or for any older children you may have.

School Lunches

Last week across both sites, there were over 40 children arriving at school each day with no lunch booking having been made. Please check that you have booked a lunch for your child, by midnight on the previous day to ensure that your child receives the lunch they want.

At Sandpits Road, if no booking had been made, your child will not be offered a choice and will receive the hot lunch option for that day.

At Clee View, not everyone receives a free school lunch. Therefore, accurate numbers need to be given to the cooks each day to ensure that there is enough food for everyone who requires a lunch. This means that if no booking has been made, your child will not be included in the numbers given to the kitchens, and there may not be enough food cooked for your them to have a lunch.

If you have been online to order lunches for your child, please check that there is nothing left in your basket in the top right-hand corner of your screen. If there is a number showing in your basket, it means that you still need to check out and confirm the order. If you do not pay for lunches - either because your child has a Universal Free School Meal or is entitled to Free School Meals, you still need to check out and 'pay' but will not be charged.
