Parents will be able to collect LFT Home Kits and ask any questions you may have about Testing and Vaccinations. The team will be available on the carpark from approx. 2.30 pm on both sites.

There is no need to book an appointment.

- develop an awareness of the diversity of the UK and the wider world


These visits would be delivered as part of our whole school assemblies (on both Clee View & Sandpits Road Site).

We have our own self-contained, spacious facilities together with a large natural outdoor area. We have full access to all school facilities. We have a nurturing, supportive and experienced team of staff who value each child as unique and independent learners. Our provision is child-led which means that staff continually observe, assess and interact with children to get a comprehensive grasp of their stage of development, unique styles of learning and areas of interest. It is important to us that all parents are actively encouraged to be involved in their child's education and we place great importance on communication between the setting and home.

We understand that choosing the right setting for your child is an extremely important decision.

We are open term time -Monday to Friday -9.00am to 3.00 pm. We offer morning (9.00am-11.30am), afternoon (12.30pm-3.00pm) or full day sessions.


We are currently full, but places will be available for January 2022

The dates are Tuesday 12th and Wednesday 13th October 3.30-6pm


Meetings will be via Microsoft Teams or a telephone call, and further information will be available next week.
