Happy New Year!

It's been lovely to see the children back in school.

As we anticipated, there have been cases of Covid popping up over Christmas and New Year and, therefore, some children are starting the term isolating at home. If parents contact school to inform us that their child is off/isolating with Covid, please expect a message on Dojo from the class teacher to ask if children are fit to learn. If they are, staff in the younger years will set work linked to current class learning for the child to complete. Older children (Y3-6) will also be set work but may be invited to join the classroom via TEAMS for morning lessons. Any questions or issues, please contact class teachers directly on Dojo.

In addition, with the uncertainty surrounding COVID cases nationally, we have opted for a cautious approach to running clubs this term. We are limiting the mixing across year groups for the time being. This means that the range of clubs will be scaled back and limited to sports clubs that can take place outdoors. Clubs will start in a couple of weeks providing cases remain low. Further information regarding clubs will be coming out shortly.

Reporting Pupil Absence

Please ensure that you advise the school of **ALL** pupil absence. Contact on the first day ideally needs to be via a telephone call by 9 am at the latest (you may leave a voice message). If your child is ill, please clarify the nature of the illness. Further absence notification can be sent via other means, Class DOJO/email etc. Please keep in regular contact, for example, every second day of a lengthy absence, so we may keep our registers up to date as we are required to.

School Start Time

Please be on time for school every day. All children should be in the classroom by 9.00am.

Being late is disruptive for your child and school staff who must manage it. Punctuality will be closely monitored this term and support given to those who are persistently late.

All learning time is valuable so please help us to avoid unnecessary delays at the start of the day.

We have noticed that quite a few children have worn trainers to school this week instead of school shoes. Trainers are not part of school uniform, so please make sure your child comes to school in appropriate footwear.

Starting School in September 2022

Children can start school in reception at the beginning of the academic year following their fourth birthday. Therefore, children born between 1 September 2017 and 31 August 2018 can start primary school from September 2022.

- An application **must** be made and the closing date for applications is **15 January 2022**.
- Residents of Shropshire local authority must make their applications online via Shropshire Council website.
