If you have any spare plants or compost which you would be willing to donate at either site, we would be very grateful.



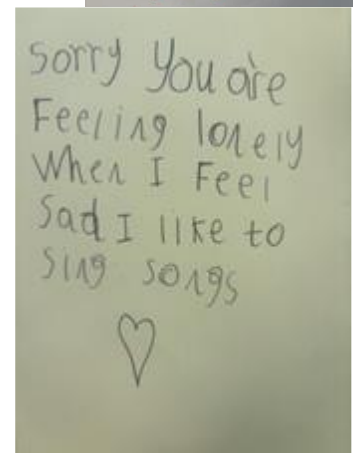
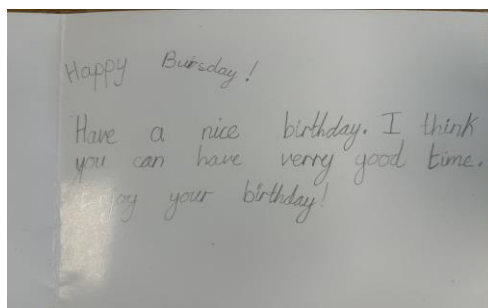
